M. Phil (Anatomy)

Course Overview

Course Duration

: 02 (two) years.

Study Period :

Part-I : Six months.

Part-II : Six months.

Final Part : One year.

Date of Commencement of Course

: July of each year.

Eligibility for Admission:

- **MBBS** or its equivalent degree recognized by B.M.D.C.
- Completion of a period of 2 (two) years after graduation (MBBS/equiv. degree).
- Maximum 45 years of age.

Examination format:

M. Phil (Anatomy) Part-I Examination: On completion of first six months after enrolment.

II. M. Phil (Anatomy) Part-II Examination

On successful completion of Part-I examination or after passing at least two papers in Part-I examination, a candidate will be promoted to Part-II or may enroll in Part-II course in the immediate next session

After enrolment in Part-II, a candidate may appear after 06 (six) months in Part-II examination along with carry on Paper (if any) of Part-I course

A candidate must clear the Part-II examination within a maximum of two consecutive years from enrolment in the Part-II course, after which the candidate shall be barred from continuing the course

A candidate must pass the final Part (Thesis) within 03 (three) consecutive years of joining the course after which the candidate shall be dropped from the course.
