



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for MD/MS Phase-A Residency Program March 2027

1. Question:

Which documents a candidate should have during submission of her/his application?

Answer:

Following documents are required to provide correct information,

- Permanent and updated BMDC Registration (valid on or after 31 August 2027).
- National Identification Card (NID).
- Internship Certificate.
- Job Related Documents.

2. Question:

Which items a Candidate have to scan and upload along with the application?

Answer:

A Candidate should scan images (.jpg format) of-

- Her/his passport size color Photograph (image size : 500×500 px, not older than three months & background must be of one color preferably white where face should be very clearly seen)
- Signature (image size : 300×200 px) and
- Bank Deposit Receipt (image size : 500×500 px)

3. Question:

Which information from Bank Deposit Receipt is to be mentioned?

Answer:

- Bank batch/serial number (Maximum digit of numbers-which is to write in 1st field)
- Scroll number (without Shahbag Avenue branch, all branches Scroll number is 1-which is to write in 2nd field)
- Date of Money deposit (Select from calendar of Online system)
- Name of the Branch

4. Question:

When a candidate can get her/his Admit Card?

Answer:

Candidates for Medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics & Dental Faculty can print Admit Card from 25 October to 06 November 2026 and Candidates for Basic Science & Paraclinical Science Faculty can print Admit Card from 30 November to 05 December 2026 (upto 8.30AM) using his/her application number & password.

5. Question:

Is there any age limit for applying?

Answer:

- Maximum 45-year age as on 28 February 2027 (candidate with date of birth 01 March 1982 or after can apply).
- Age is relaxable upto 52 years only for Private Candidates having Diploma degree. (candidate with date of birth 01 March 1975 or after can apply).
- BMU Candidates :
 - Age is relaxable upto 57-years only for BMU Candidates who are appointed from 2003 to 2006 (candidate with date of birth 01 March 1970 or after can apply). and
 - Others 52 years (candidate with date of birth 01 March 1975 or after can apply).

6. Question:

Is completion of internship mandatory?

Answer: Yes, must complete one year internship.

7. Question:

Is any period is necessary after internship?

Answer:

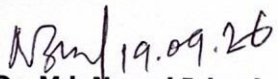
Yes, one year after completion of internship on or before 28 February 2027 is mandatory.

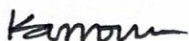
8. Question:

Is provisional registration number of BMDC is acceptable?

Answer:

No, candidate must have permanent registration number of BMDC, validity on or after 31 August 2027.

9. Question:

How many years need to serve before applying for admission into a Post-graduate course for a government candidate?

Answer:

At least 2 (two) years of service for all courses except in the following cases:

i. Applicants intend to apply for the following courses do not require any work experience at any level:

a. All disciplines under Faculty of Basic Science and Para Clinical Science.

b. MD Residency Program in Anesthesiology under Faculty of Surgery and Transfusion Medicine under Faculty of Medicine.

ii. Candidates with one year work experience in remote area (as per Govt. Deputation Rules) can apply for any discipline.

10. Question:

Is BMU quota applicable for Medical Officer/Research Assistant working in Bangladesh Medical University?

Answer:

Yes, BMU quota is applicable for regular Medical Officer/Research Assistant working in Bangladesh Medical University.

11. Question: How many years of government service are required after last deputation?

Answer: Candidate must know the Govt. Deputation Rules.

12. Question:

Is a candidate eligible for form fill-up after willingly leave course/course out/cancellation of deputation/failed in any previous course?

Answer:

Deputation Rules will be followed for Govt. candidates.

BMU candidates will become eligible to apply in any course after 02 (two) years of willingly withdrawal/could not pass in any previous course/course out from the course. In that case, the BMU candidate will have to compete in General Quota.

In case of private candidates, one year is required after willingly withdrawal/could not pass in any previous course/course out from the course.

13. Question :

Can a candidate choose more than one discipline?

Answer:

No, candidate has to choose one discipline only. After final submission, no change of discipline will be allowed. A candidate will be allowed to apply only once in a session.

However, only applicants under the Faculty of Basic Science and Paraclinical Science are permitted to select three subjects. No modifications to the chosen subjects will be allowed after final submission. A candidate may apply only once per session.

14. Question :

Can a candidate choose more than one institute?

Answer :

Yes, candidate can choose maximum of seven institutes (if options of institutes are available for that particular discipline).

15. Question :

How many years required for a Govt. candidate to give service in respective specialty after obtaining any postgraduate degree?

Answer :

Govt. candidates must have **one year** active service in the respective field after obtaining any postgraduate degree.

16. Question :

How many years required for a BMU & private candidate to give service in respective specialty after obtaining any postgraduate degree?

Answer :

BMU & private candidates do not require one year active service in the respective field after obtaining any postgraduate degree.

17. Question : Can a private candidate apply in Armed Forces Medical Institute?

Answer :

Yes, a private candidate can apply in Armed Forces Medical Institute where the discipline option exist in discipline list.

18. Question : Can the information provided in the application form be modified?

Answer :

Candidate can modify their application as long as she/he not pressed the 'Final Submit' button. Once the 'Final Submit' button has been pressed, candidate is no longer allowed to modify.

19. About any wrong/fake information :

If any candidate provide any wrong/fake information during online form fill-up or in any stage of admission process, his/her selection/admission will be cancelled and he/she will be subjected to legal proceedings as per procedures of Bangladesh Medical University.
